Impact of sports premium April 17- July 18

RB coaching

- RB coaching provide training for staff through curriculum support assisting staff in activity areas depending on their CDP need.
- They provide after school clubs Mon-Thurs
- Clubs have included Archery, Gymnastics and Athletics, fencing, multi skills, football, benchball, parachute games, tennis and quick cricket.

Impact

- Children are engaged in after school extra-curricular sport activities on a weekly basis. 35% of pupils access this.
- This has supported our School Games Bronze award.
- Staff confidence in planning and delivering quality PE lessons has increased.
- Questionnaires filled in by staff to show impact.
