Starting Primary School in September 2019

Why not apply for a place online? If your child was born between 1 Sept 2014 and 31 Aug 2015 they will be due to start primary school in September 2019.

You **MUST** complete an application either online at www.dudley.gov.uk/admissions or by completing an application form from your home local authority by

15 JANUARY 2019. You can include five school preferences on the application; there is nothing to gain by only putting one preference.

The online system will be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from 1 Oct 2018 until the closing date for applications on **15 JANUARY 2019**

Attendance at a nursery attached to a primary school will not guarantee admission to that particular primary school or give any advantage to the pupil in the admissions process.

Starting Secondary School in September 2019

Why not apply for a place online? If your child is due to start secondary school in 2019 then you will have to apply for a school place before 31 October 2018.

You **MUST** complete an application either online at www.dudley.gov.uk/admissions or by completing an application form from your home local authority. You can include six school preferences on the application; there is nothing to gain by only putting one preference.

The online system will be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from 1 Sept 2018 until the closing date for applications on **31 OCTOBER 2018**.

You should not assume that your child will get a place at a secondary school without you having to apply, even if you have an older child already attending the same school.
