### Easter Hats/ Egg-cellent Designs

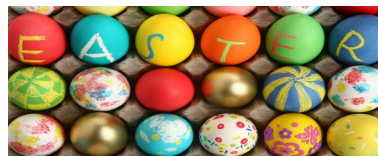
