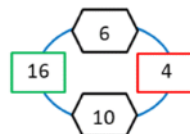

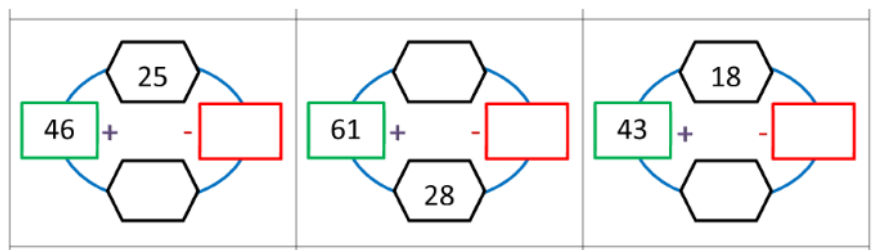
Year 5 Maths Problem
