Starting Secondary School in September 2020

Why not apply for a place online?

If your child is due to start secondary school in 2020 then you will have to apply for a school place before 31 October 2019.

You **MUST** complete an application either online at www.dudley.gov.uk/admissions or by completing the application form provided by your home local authority. You can include six school preferences on the application; there is nothing to gain by only putting one preference.

The online system will be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from 1 Sept 2019 until the closing date for applications on 31 OCTOBER 2019.

You should not assume that your child will get a place at a secondary school without you having to apply, even if you have an older child already attending the same school.
