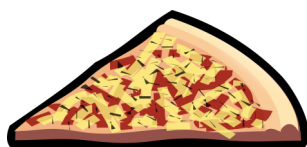

Starting Primary School in September 2018

Why not apply for a place online?

If your child was born between 1 Sept 2013 and 31 Aug 2014 they will be due to start primary school in September 2018.

You **MUST** complete an application either online at www.dudley.gov.uk/admissions or by completing an application form from your home local authority by **15 JANUARY 2018**. You can include five school preferences on the application; there is nothing to gain by only putting one preference.

The online system will be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from 1 Sept 2017 until the closing date for applications on **15 JANUARY 2018**
