Tuesday and Thursday: ICT

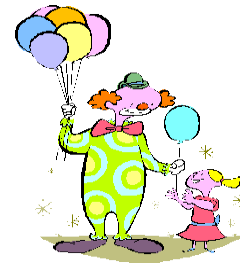
