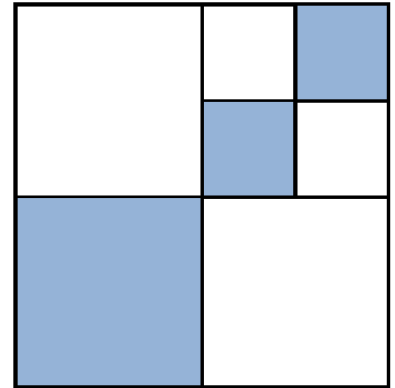
BOOKINGS
