What's Happening This Term?



English

Throughout this term, the children will learn about the book *How to Train Your Dragon*. They will create narrative, non-chronological reports and newspaper

Articles as they continue to develop their vocabulary and understanding of sentence structures in order to improve their writing. Children will also learn to punctuate direct speech and use the present

Homework

English and Maths tasks will still be set on a weekly basis alternating between online and in books set each Friday to be returned the following Friday. Mathematics

This term, children will begin by exploring angles, perimeter and shape, moving on to measure and time. Later in the term, we will improve our knowledge of time and statistics before moving back to recap and solidify our application of the four operations and fractions and decimals.



Irresistible Learning

History and Geography:

Children will be using geographical vocabulary when exploring extreme weather conditions such as tornadoes and hurricanes.

In History, the children will look at the historical tragedy of the Titanic. They will then travel back hundreds of years to study the life of the Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings.

Science:

During this term, children shall learn about animals including humans with focuses on the digestive system, skeleton and nutrition.

Computing:

Children will develop their Computing skills by learning to code.
