

### Computing

#### English

We will explore a range of texts that will be linked to our 'Bostin' Black Country' topic.

We will spend much of this term focusing on nonfiction texts such as explanations, arguments and newspaper articles. We will also focus on

#### Homework

#### Science

Children will learn about light. They will gain knowledge and understanding about how we see things and how light travels. By undertaking a variety of practical investigations, children will develop their skills in working scientifically. We will investigate how shadows are made larger and smaller when moved towards and away from the light source as well as practically demonstrating how light travels in straight lines.

#### Maths

We will be securing our knowledge of number facts and use of all four operations. We will investigate shape and space and will apply our learning in a variety of problem solving contexts. It would also be very helpful if children could practise their times tables at home.

#### Art

In Art, children will be using a range of media to produce artwork in the style of Lowry. They will depict typical industrialised Black Country scenes. In the second half term, we will the focusing on Canal art.
