COVID UPDATE

Cases are rising. Please stick to the guidelines, get tested, continue to wear a mask and follow social distancing when on school premises. Symptoms in children include a new, continuous cough, a high temperature, a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste, headaches, sore throat, runny nose, sneezing, aches and pains, tummy ache, feeling very tired for no good reason. If your child has any of these symptoms, please book a PCR test (not a lateral flow test.) The restrictions will stay in place until the end of term.

Cars on Site

Only visitors to school who have obtained permission can come down the drive. Please do not tailgate, **do not use your mobile phone while driving on school premises**, remember the speed limit is **5mph**. If you are driving on site please be mindful of others. It is very busy and we need to minimise the risks. Do not park on the staff car park. Many thanks.

The last day of term is Wednesday 21st July. Normal finishing time. Thursday 2nd & Friday 3rd September are INSET days. The children return on Monday 6th September.

Children should arrive on school premises no more than 10 minutes before their session starts. Several children are arriving too early and are not supervised.

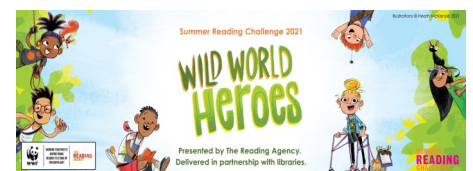
