# Starting Primary School in September 2021

Why not apply for a place online?
If your child was born between 1 Sept
2017 and 31 Aug 2018 they will be
due to start primary school in
September 2022.

You MUST complete an application either online at www.dudley.gov.uk/admissions or by completing an application form from your home local authority by 15 JANUARY 2022. You can include five school preferences on the application; there is nothing to gain by only putting one preference.

The online system will be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from **1 Oct 2021** until the closing date for

applications on **15 JANUARY 2022**Attendance at a nursery attached to a primary school will not guarantee admission to that particular primary school or give any advantage to the pupil in the admissions process.

# Starting Secondary School in September 2022

Why not apply for a place online?
If your child is due to start secondary school in 2022 then you will have to apply for a school place before 31 October 2021.

You MUST complete an application either online at www.dudley.gov.uk/ admissions or by completing the application form provided by your home local authority. You can include six school preferences on the application; there is nothing to gain by only putting one preference.

The online system will be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from 1 Sept 2021 until the closing date for applications on

31 OCTOBER 2021.
