FOLLOW THE FIREWORK CODE

If you must have fireworks at home, please follow this safety advice.



- · Only buy fireworks from retailers · Don't drink alcohol if setting off registered with MFRS
- · Keep fireworks in a closed box
- · Follow the instructions on each firework
- · Light them at arm's length, using a taper
- Stand well back
- · Always supervise children around fireworks
- · Light sparklers one at a time and wear gloves
- · Keep pets indoors

DON'Ts

- fireworks
- Never go near a firework that has been lit. Even if it hasn't gone off, it could still explode
- · Never put fireworks in your pocket or throw them
- Never give sparklers to a child under five
- Don't let fireworks off after 11pm

Starting Primary School in September 2021

Why not apply for a place online? If your child was born between 1 Sept 2017 and 31 Aug 2018 they will be due to start primary school in September 2022.

You **MUST** complete an application either online at www.dudley.gov.uk/ admissions or by completing an application form from your home local authority by 15 JANUARY 2022. You can include five school preferences on the application; there is nothing to gain by only putting one preference. The online system will be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from

1 Oct 2021 until the closing date for applications on 15 JANUARY 2022 Attendance at a nursery attached to a primary school will not guarantee admission to that particular primary school or give any advantage to the pupil in the admissions process.

Please apply even if your children are in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 as children who are entitled to benefits assessed free school meals attract more funding for the school
