Toddlers had a super session at forest school this week, making mud pies, bird feeders and having marshmallows and hot chocolate round the fire!


Reception and Nursery have enjoyed learning about jobs and people who help us and have been dressing up and acting out what they want to be when they are grown ups!

We hope you are all enjoying the reading challenge and have made a start with the lovely book choices.


Weekly Maths Problem
