Key Stage 2 News

We have all enjoyed starting up our Singing Assembly time over the last few weeks. The children have tried really had to sing and have also learnt some amazing sign language.

The children in years 3 and 4 have continued their work on East Anglia. They have used research and design skills to make amazing travel brochures for Cambridge. Years 5 and 6, are continuing to enjoy their Guided Reading texts - George's Secret Key to the Universe (by Lucy and Stephen Hawking) and Cosmic (by Frank Cottrell Boyce). Starting Primary School in September 2023

Why not apply for a place online? If your child was born between 1 Sept 2018 and 31 Aug 2019 they will be due to start primary school in September 2023.

You MUST complete an application either online at www.dudley.gov.uk/ admissions or by completing an application form from your home local authority by 15 JANUARY 2023. You can include five school preferences on the application; there is nothing to gain by only putting one preference.

The online system will be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from 1 Oct 2022 until the closing date for applications on 15 JANUARY 2023

Attendance at a nursery attached to a primary school will not guarantee admission to that particular primary school or give any advantage to the pupil in the admissions process.

Starting Secondary School in September 2023

Why not apply for a place online? If your child is due to start secondary school in 2023 then you will have to apply for a school place before 31 October 2022.

You **MUST** complete an application either online at www.dudley.gov.uk/admissions or by completing the application form provided by your home local authority. You can include six school preferences on the application; there is nothing to gain by only putting one preference.

The online system will be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from 1 Sept 2022 until the closing date for applications on

31 OCTOBER 2022


