Cars

Scarlet Fever/Strep A bacteria infection.

Scarlet fever or Strep A is a highly contagious bacterial infection that can be extremely serious - although it is treatable with antibiotics.

In England and Wales it's a notifiable disease meaning health professionals must inform local health protection teams of suspected cases so they can be treated quickly and possible outbreaks brought under control. Spread in coughs and sneezes, cases occur most often in the winter. Symptoms include a rash, a sore throat, flushed cheeks and swollen tongueknown as 'strawberry tongue' because of its appearance.

If you think you, or your child, have scarlet fever, do seek medical help as soon as possible.

Early treatment with antibiotics is important as it helps reduce the risk of complications and the spread of the infection to others.

We do not have any cases in school but we wanted to raise awareness due to the news today. (Source-BBC NEWS)

Calling Ashwood Scientists!

Did you get Mrs Bunn's science challenge correct?



The object that was zoomed in on was a soap bubble!

Bubbles of air can happen in many different ways but they don't all float like soap bubbles. For example, when you swim underwater, the bubbles you produce just remain in the water and don't last long. You may have also seen bubbles in carbonated drinks, which are made from carbon dioxide as it rises to the surface of the liquid. However, bubbles made from soap and water are the most fun as they can float in the air!

Try it at home!

Can you devise your own investigation based on producing the best bubble mixture using water and washing up liquid? Which ratio of these ingredients will make the best bubble? How will you define 'the best bubble?' (i.e. long lasting, biggest, etc). How will you make this a fair test? How will they measure results? 
