## Dear Parents, Carers and Friends

### Parking Update:

School Governors have reviewed site safety including the movement of vehicles on our school grounds. From **Monday 27<sup>th</sup> February** access will only be permitted to those holding a current Blue Badge disabled parking permit.

If you have made an application to park on the school site, please present your Blue Badge to the School Office so that we can finalise your application and allocate your number.

When parking on site please adhere to the following:

- Speak to the School Office to gain access stating your allocated number. Please wait for a response before getting back in your vehicle.
- Do not tailgate the car in front
- Park in an allocated bay and not on the Staff car park
- Maximum speed limit 5mph
- Avoid the taxi drop off area
- Do not walk across the car park.
- Do use the pavements to your child's classroom.
- Leave your engine switched off and do not move your car until the site is clear to do so
