### School Uniform Reminder

In preparation for your annual uniform shopping trips over the summer holiday, we would like to give you a reminder of our school uniform. Please could you provide:

\* a bottle green "V" neck jumper or cardigan

\* tie (green/gold single striped)

- \* a white shirt / blouse
- \* grey trousers / shorts

\* a grey skirt / a pinafore dress (of a respectable length)

\* sensible black shoes should be worn for school, NOT trainers

\* a PE Kit consisting of green shorts, a gold Ashwood Park T-shirt and a pair of black pumps (provided in a PE bag).

#### Every item of uniform should be marked with the child's name so that we are able to return them when lost.

Uniform clothing should be purchased from the typical uniform range available in many supermarket and affordable stores. Uniform should not be fashion items of the same colour.

Please do not allow your child to come to school wearing trainers, leggings, short skirts or football socks. These items do not form part of our uniform policy.

Could you also ensure that your child does not wear excessive jewellery. The children are permitted to wear 1 pair of stud earrings and a watch.

We hope that you will give your support to this uniform as the children look very smart when dressed in a similar fashion. It also helps the children to develop a pride in their appearance and a sense of belonging to the school

Our school uniform is now available from TOTALLY UNIFORM in Kingswinford.



## **REVISED Start Time.**

From September we will be changing morning Registration times. Registration for all pupils will be 8.45am.

Pupils will line up in their playground and will be taken into class by a member of staff.

Late arrivals will need to go through the office and be signed in by an adult.

Anyone arriving after 8.55am will be marked 'L' (late). Any pupil arriving after Registers are closed at 9.15 am will be marked 'U' (unauthorised absence).
