Free School Meal Application

If you get any of the following support payments your child may be entitled to receive free school meals:

- * Income Support
- * Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- * Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- * Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 the guaranteed element of State
- * Pension Credit
- * Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- * Working Tax Credit Run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- * Universal Credit (you must have less than £616.67 a month net earned income (after tax - and not including any benefits)
- * Children who receive a qualifying benefit in their own right are also allowed to receive free school meals.

If your child receives **UNIVERSAL Free School Meals (KS1)** but you are eligible for general Free School Meals, as detailed above, please apply as this helps our school budget.
